Book Bingo on the Patio

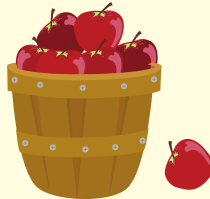
Monday, October 4 @ 3:30 pm on Madison Ave patio

Little Artists Grab & Go: Bats & Cats

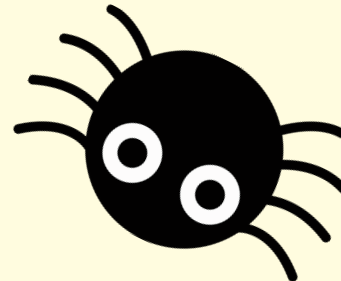
Friday, October 15 / Saturday, October 16
